

BURREN JOURNEY

DAY AND HALF-DAY OUTINGS

Spend a day or a half-day with us in a southern corner of the Burren. 'Burren Journey' is run by Brendan and Nelleke McGrath. Brendan is author of 'Landscape and Society in Contemporary Ireland', published by Cork University Press in 2013. Nelleke is a biodynamic gardener. The Burren Journey team includes archaeologists, ecologists, anglers and cavers and local farmers. We are based at 'Riverstown Cottage', which is just outside Corofin village. Every day is different but most days consist of a morning walk and then something different in the afternoon. The walk is either a general introduction to the landscape or a closer look at some special aspect of landscape. Afternoon activities include fishing, caving, gardening and exploring local farms with the farmer. To enjoy a day with us you need to be reasonably fit and mobile. You should wear comfortable outdoor clothing, including good shoes for walking and be prepared for all kinds of weather. We supply equipment when it is needed for particular activities, e.g. for fishing or caving.

Our groups are always small and you will be in the company of an experienced guide or practitioner.

The morning walk is from 10 to 12.30. The all-day programme is from 10 to 4.30 and includes a packed lunch or buffet lunch. You need to book in advance (the day before or earlier).

There is no charge for children (under 16) on the morning walks provided they are with an adult. There is a €10 charge for children who spend the day with us.

You must check availability in advance either by phone or email. Then on the day make your way to 'Riverstown Cottage', just outside Corofin (see map). Turn off the main road at the grotto on the edge of the village. We are 1 mile (1.5km) down the road, beside the river. There is parking beside the house.



We also provide tailor-made half-day and day-long programmes for groups (up to a maximum of 12 people).
